### ■ Crucial Guidelines for Young Investigator Award (YIA) Candidates:

<First-round Selection: Abstract Evaluation>

- Evaluation method: Selection committee members will score the abstracts.
- The number of abstracts to be selected is five (5) for AOMC-YIA and six (6) for JMS-YIA.
- Candidates who pass the first round will be notified in advance.
- Candidates whose abstracts are not selected for the second round will do their presentation in the Oral or Poster Sessions.

<Second-round Selection: Oral Presentation on Day 3 - September 14>

- Evaluation method: Selection committee members will vote on the presentations during the AOMC-YIA (9:00-10:30) and JMS-YIA (10:40-12:30) Sessions, respectively.
- Presentation time: Each candidate will give a twelve (12) minute presentation, with an additional six (6) minute Q&A.
- Result Announcement: The winners of the Most Outstanding YIA and the Excellent YIA will be announced at the Award and Closing Ceremony. We kindly request that all YIA candidates attend the Award and Closing Ceremony to celebrate the conference's achievements and the Young Investigator Award winners.

### ■ Crucial Guidelines for Student Award (SA) Candidates:

<First-round Selection: Poster Presentation on Day 2 - September 13>

- Evaluation method: Selection committee members will evaluate the posters during the designated poster session on Day 2, September 13, from 18:30 to 19:30.

- Presentation time: It will be a three (3) minute presentation with an additional two (2) minutes of Q&A.
- All posters must be displayed by noon on Day 2, September 13.
- Failure to do so will result in exclusion from the selection process.
- Participants will be notified of their selection for the next round by a mark on their posters between 19:30 and 20:00 on the presentation day.

<Second-round Selection: Oral Presentation on Day 4 - September 15>

- Evaluation method: Selection committee members will vote on the presentations during the JMS-SA session on Day 4, September 15, from 8:00 to 8:50.
- Presentation time: It will be a seven (7) minute presentation, with an additional five (5) minute Q&A.
- Result Announcement: The winners of the Most Outstanding SA and the Excellent SA will be announced at the Award and Closing Ceremony.

To ensure a smooth second-round selection process, all SA candidates must have their presentation slides prepared and ready in advance.

The order of the oral presentations during the second-round selection will follow the ascending order of the abstract ID numbers.

Failure to attend the second-round selection will result in disqualification from the competition and the opportunity to win the Student Award.

We kindly request that all second-round candidates attend the Award and Closing Ceremony to celebrate the conference's achievements and the Student Award winners.
